Dear St. John's Family,

Due to the "Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Health Requiring Universal Face Coverings" released on Wednesday, July 1, we are now implementing the following plan regarding current worship at St. John's. (We have been informed from a member of the PA Family Institute that churches are NOT exempt from this order, and we believe that wearing a facial mask for an entire hour-long worship service in the sanctuary is not conducive to the worship environment that we seek to create.)

Starting this Sunday, July 5:

10:30 am worship:

- Livestream Only
- The livestream is available on the homepage of our website (www.ilovestjohns.org)
- The sanctuary will NOT be open for public worship

7:00 pm worship:

- Outside in the Grove
- Masks are NOT required outside as long as social distancing guidelines are met (per section 2 of the order). You are welcome to wear a facial mask if you desire.
- There is no maximum attendance number
- There is no need to request attending the service, simply come and worship with us
- Seating is on the benches provided or on the lawn chairs you bring from home
- There must be 6 feet of distance between families of different households
- Singing will be part of the worship experience
- Please, for everyone's safety, no shaking hands, hugging, etc. among families of different households
- The service will be <u>cancelled</u> if there is rain or an official heat advisory
